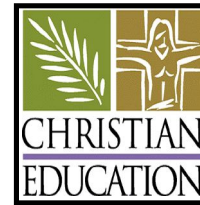
1. Nov 7<sup>th</sup> **Youth Helpers Needed.** Please see **Becky Brickman** or **Kevin Wyatt** for more info.
